7 Day Binational 1000 Islands Itinerary

Day 1 A bit of Historical Flavor



Start your adventure with a bit of history dating back to the War of 1812. This village was vital to our nation's security. The Sackets Harbor Experience guided tour explores the Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site, the Pickering Beach Museum, the Visitor's Center & more.



Day 2 Cultural Immersion & Sightseeing



Experience three heritage centers and some time on the water today. The nation's largest freshwater boat museum, the Antique Boat Museum houses a variety of vintage boats while the Thousand Islands Art Center and the Thousand Islands History Museum round out our community's classics. Hop aboard Clayton Island Tours for an exclusive tour of Rock Island Lighthouse with access to the Lantern Room with amazing views of the St. Lawrence Seaway.



Day 3 Castles & Mansions



Prepare to step in the footsteps of the Gilded-Age millionaires and barons as you embark on Uncle Sam Boat Tour's Two Castle Cruise. Colorful narration during the cruise will enlighten your sense of history, adventure and imagination. Explore both Singer and Boldt castles' mansions with helpful docents to learn the fate of the families. Post voyage enjoy a refreshing beverage at a local winery or distillery for a taste of the 1000 islands.



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Day 4 Step up to a step back in time



Some of the most breathtaking views are from above. The 1000 Islands Tower takes you 130 meters (400ft) in the air to 3 levels of observation. Travel east to Upper Canada Village for a view of St. Lawrence River life in the 1860s at our region's most recognized living history site.

Day 5 Arts & Culture



Brockville is bursting as a center of group activities. A bit of history can be learned as you explore Fulford Place Mansion and all it's glory. Filled with artifacts and stories this is truly a gem for groups. A visit to the Aquarium at Tall Ships Landing will provide a peek at our natural history while the Brockville Museum explores past residents. Canada's oldest railway tunnel can be found and explored here. The scenic walk through the tunnel is lighted and has sound and is 1/4 mile walk.

Day 6 Where the water goes over the rocks



Rockport Boat line offers several tours to explore the waters of the northern St. Lawrence and provides additional opportunities to visit Boldt Castle. Gananoque's indigenous beginning is shared with neighboring towns but their stories are their own. Learn more at the 1000 Islands History Museum. Take in a show at the Gananoque Playhouse, a professional theatre in a historic setting.

Day 7 First Capital Experience



Today, explore Canada's first capital city and home to the nation's first Prime Minister, Bellevue House. Fort Henry shares it's pride and pageantry with live demonstrations while the Great Lakes Museum explores the waters the fort was to defend.



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
